CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Exhibitors must display 80% of replacement ewe hoggets with a minimum of 250
- 2 TOOTH flocks must display 100% of replacements
- Ewe hogget's must be bred by exhibitor to be eligible for Champion of Champions
- Ewe hoggets must be showing only milk teeth
- Ewe hogget's can be woolly or shorn
- All breeders of flock hoggets are eligible
- Sheep must be yarded and able to be put up a race
- Distance to yards must be given to Convenor for time allocations in the timetable for the day of judging.
- The exhibitor must have completed the Production Form to give to the Convenor on the day of judging, and be prepared to give a verbal summary of their Production Form to judges and spectators, including what other things they are doing on-farm e.g. dairy grazing, cropping, overview of breeding objectives, where they are at with their sheep, what changes they are trying to make etc.
- To be eligible, the exhibitor must be present on the day of judging and preferably be at prize-giving
- \$10 Entry Fee – Payable in cash on the day to the Convenor
